HOTEL INFORMATION

Rooms are available in the AGRiP block at the Hyatt Regency Orlando, which is also the conference venue. After you register for the conference, you will get additional information to make reservations. If you make reservations outside the block, AGRiP will not be able to help you with any rooming issues.

Rooms are available on a ②rst-come, ②rst-served basis until Friday, Feb. 7, or until sold out. Room rates start at \$259 per night (plus tax and service fees). An optional \$25 resort fee per night includes a range of amenities (e.g., ②tness center access, trolley tickets).

CONFERENCE REGISTRATION RATES

Registration received before 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, Feb. 9, is \$770 for AGRiP members and \$1,095 for non-members. After that, a \$100 late registration fee will be applied.
